

Release Notes for Connection Info Editor

v2.2 build 1

1. **Problem:** The DB Password is not encrypted on new record when the Encrypt Password check box is checked.
Status: This problem is fixed.
2. **Modification:** Only allow user to change the Connection Info ID to greater than 1000, IDs range from 1 to 1000 are reserved.
3. **Modification:** Automatically insert a Connection Info record for the VEMAX Support Site if it does not exist.

v2.2 build 0

1. **Enhancement:** Connection Info Editor now supports Windows Server 2008.
2. **Upgrade:** The third party controls (such as the grids, edit controls, etc) have been upgraded to the latest version.

v2.0 build 1

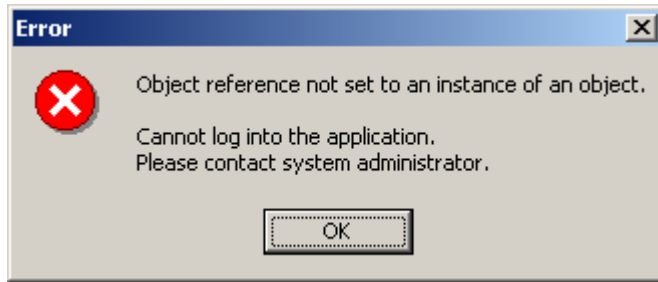
1. **New Feature:** Added “Test Connection” button for testing the connection to the database.

v2.0 build 0

1. **Upgrade:** Connection Info Editor has been upgraded to support version 2 of the Microsoft .NET Framework. The [iBOSToolsPrerequisites_2_0.exe](#) install is needed for this version of the Connection Info Editor.
2. **Upgrade:** The third party controls (such as the grids, edit controls, etc) have been upgraded to the latest version.
3. **Modification:** Grid Layout and Form Layout settings are now stored by the Connection Info Editor User ID instead of Computer/Windows User ID combination. i.e. the settings are only specific to the Connection Info Editor user, not the computer that the user is running the software from.

1. **Problem:** An object reference error occurs when the System DB Name in the table “tblConnectionInfo” is not the same as in the file “Vemax.GlobalInfo.dat”.
Status: This problem is fixed.
